The Parents as Teachers program will give your children a great start. The program includes:

Personal Visits: A special time for you and your child with a certified parent educator.

Parent Workshops: A time with other parents to gain new insights, share experiences, and discuss topics of interest to parents and young children.

Developmental Screenings: A time to check your child's development.

Connection to Community Resources in the Lincoln community.

Family Activities and Support

Stop-n-Play: A playgroup that meets 2-3 times each month for children birth to age five (pre-kindergarten). Age-appropriate activities, snack, and group time are offered during Stop-n-Play. **Special Family Events:** A time to meet other parents in the community and have fun playing with your family.

Resource Library: Parenting resources are available in the Center and at Playgroup on topics such as discipline, child care, and the importance of reading and play.
